

SOCIAL PROTECTION AND DEVELOPMENT SCHEMES FOR CHILDREN

Palanhar Yojana

- Vulnerable children like orphans children of parents with death penalty/life imprisonment, children of widows, children of parents suffering from HIV/AIDS, leprosy, disabled/divorced, abandoned woman children below 18, no earning siblings.
- A range of Rs. 500/- to 2000/- given to child (as per category).
- One should reside in Rajasthan for 3yrs. & his/her family income is not more than 1.2 lakhs.
- Application to be filed in/at: DCR/DCPU

Sukanaya Samridhi Yojana

- For Girl child (Below 10 years).
- Total amount deposited+Interest decided by government after girl completes age of 18 years.
- Application to be filed in/at: Authorized bank or Post office

SABALA/Rajiv Gandhi Kishori Balika Sashaktikaran Yojana

- School drop out girls from 11-18 years of age and all the girls from 15 to 18 years of age.
- Provision of nutrition and health education, guidance on family welfare, vocational training and life skills access to education and public services.
- Application to be filed in/at: Anganwadi centre

Janani Shishu Suraksha Yojana (JSSY)

- For pregnant women & new born baby.
- Free delivery and all medical facilities.
- Provision of 30 days free treatment of new born and other medical facilities.
- Application to be filed in/at: Government institutional facility/hospitals

Garima Balika Sanrakshan Samman Yojana (GBSSY)

- Girls/ Organisation and Individual who have worked to protect the girls from child marriages, abuse, exploitation is eligible to avail the facility of this scheme.
- Cash prize ₹ 25,000/- given to the beneficiary under this scheme.
- Application to be filed in/at: Directorate of Women Empowerment

Mukhyamantri Saksham Balika Yojana

- Adolescent girls and boys from rural areas.
- Self-defence training to girls and proper guidance to boys and help them understand value of women.
- Application to be filed in/at: Department of youth affairs and sports

Mukhyamantri Hunar Vikas Yojana

- Beneficiaries of Palanhar Yojana and children staying in Institutional Home from age of (17- 21) year.
- Provide skill development programs & sustains them from home to independent life.
- Application to be filed in/at: Non-government organizations

Free Scooty Distribution/Devnarayan Scooty Yojana

- Girl from OBC category, resident of Rajasthan, have scored above 50% of marks in her HSC & annual income of family not more than ₹ 2 Lakhs.
- Scooty in their first year, Scholarship for 2nd & 3rd year student will get ₹ 10,000/- & for PG course it is ₹ 20,000/-per year.
- Girl obtaining scholarship under other scheme shall not be eligible for the benefits of scheme.
- Application to be filed in/at: Colleges registered with any gov. organizations

Chatra Greh Kiraya Yojana

- Students from tribal sub plan and Scheduled tribe
- Get financial help from bank for house rent
- Application to be filed in/at: www.ssdg.rajasthan.gov.in

Ashram Chatrawas Mein Nishulk Coaching

- Students from OBC Category must attain required marks in

the entrance examinations.

- Documents required are mark sheets, income certificate, family not more than ₹ 3 lakhs per annum.
- Student must attend coaching daily (30% seats are reserved for girls).
- ₹ 15,000/- to 20,000/- is given depending on the coaching centre.
- Application to be filed in/at: www.sje.rajasthan.gov.in

Mukhayamantri rajshri yojana

- This scheme is for girl child born after July 2016.
- A help of 50,000 is provided by govt. at different stages.
- Bhamasah card of mother is required
- Application to be filed in/at: Anganwadi centre/State medical institute

Pradhan Mantri Matritva Sahayog Yojana (PMMSY)/ Pradhan Mantri Matritva Vandana Yojana (PMMVY)

- For pregnant women & lactating mothers of age 19yr or above (upto two children).
- Financial support of ₹ 6000/- is given under this scheme.
- Application to be filed in/at: Anganwadi centre

Aapki Beti Yojana

- Girl child from class 1st to 12th(below poverty line or any parent dead)
- Rs. 1100/- per year to girls of class 1st to 8th & Rs. 1500/- for 9th to 12th.
- Application to be filed in/at: District Education Officer (Primary/Secondary education)

Pre-Matric Scholarships to the Children of those engaged in Unclean Occupations

- Child must be Indian whose parents engaged in scavenging tanners, flayers.
- Day Scholars: Class I to X- ₹ 110/- for ten months, Hostellers: Class III to X- ₹ 700/- for ten months.
- Application to be filed in/at: The concerned department of the state government or union territory

Chief Minister Free Coaching Yojana

- The applicant (Resident of Rajasthan) should be residing in hostels run by social justice and employment department and should be a student of 11th or 12th class, For IIM; the applicants must be regular students.
- The household income of the applicant should not be more than ₹ 2.5 Lakh per annum.
- % in class 10th for SC/ST/OBC- 60% (70% for medical), General- 70% (80%) and % for graduation courses – 60%.
- Application to be filed in/at: sjms.rajasthan.gov.in.

Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidhalaya/Chatrawas Yojana

- Girls belonging to SC, ST, OBC, minority communities and families below the poverty line in educationally backward blocks.
- Minimum reservation of 75% of the seats for girls belonging to SC, ST, OBC or minority communities and priority for the remaining 25%, is accorded to girls from families below poverty line.
- Application to be filed in/at: Block education officer

Mukhayamantri Subhlakshami Yojana

- Girl child born in government hospitals of Rajasthan.
- ₹ 2100/- to the mother on the birth, ₹ 2100/- after 1yr (with all the immunization), ₹ 3100/- on admission in school
- Application to be filed in/at: Sate level medical institutions/ Community health centres

Ashram Chatrawas Yojana

- Students of class 6th-12th belonging to SC, ST, OBC, Minority Communities and Below Poverty Line families.
- Food, School uniform, Oil, soap, Mattress, sheets, pillow, laundry, Newspaper, magazines.
- Application to be filed in/at: District social welfare officer/ District office, social justice and empowerment department
